## **❖** WP1: Management

### Evaluation result of the mid-term report.

The grant coordinator gave a brief presentation about the feedback letter from the EU about the mid-term report, and inform all partners that the feedback was (Good) and discussed with all partners the remarks from EU to be considered in the future. He also noted that the external quality report is appreciated.

Representatives of all partners gave their feedback and discussed all issues noted in the mid-term report.

# Communicated with the project officer regarding the equipment and staff cost for Lebanese and Syrian partners due to financial restrictions

The grant coordinator gave a brief presentation about the virtual meeting with the project officer in Brussels,, Mr Clivio Gazali and the National Erasmus+ Officer in Lebanon, Dr Aref Alsoufi. He discussed with all partners the critical financial situation in Lebanon, and presented several scenarios of how to receive the second installment. He explained that the second pre-financing will be paid only if 70% of the first pre-financing amount has been spent.

- -1<sup>st</sup> option: European partners may send back certain amount from their staff costs to buy equipment and these amounts will be sent back to them after receiving the second installment.
- 2nd option: Transferring amount from travel cost and cost of stay to equipment budget, It was agreed that the EU partners need permission from the project officer in EACEA to transfer part of the money to buy the equipment
  - Staff cost documents (waiting the signed and stamped documents as well as the contracts)

The grant coordinator asked partners who did not send financial documents to send to BAU as soon as possible.

#### Next face to face meeting

The grant coordinator proposed that next steering committee to be held physically depending (on) the covid-19 pandemic situation, in Greece during the month of September (2021)

# WP2 Needs Analysis (capacity building)

#### Discussion of evaluation results

The grant coordinator confirmed that this work package is accomplished, all documents (2 reports) are on the website, and they are the basis for other WPs (3.4.5). He highlighted that two roundtables were organized in Lebanon and in Syria to disseminate the results

### **❖** WP3 (capacity building),

#### Evaluation of training modules 1 and 2

The grant coordinator discussed with all partners the current situation, the current activities and the future plan. 2 ToTs have been conducted by the University of Bologna and University of Alicante. He asked partners who are responsible for quality assurance of the project to send questionnaires after each ToT to all participants to assure the quality of the training.

#### Planning of modules 3 and 4

The grant coordinator informed all partners that the plan for the other remaining two ToTs is as follow:  $3^{rd}$  ToT will be held next June by 4 Elements (15, 16, 17 of June 2021), and the  $4^{th}$  ToT next July to be held by Oldenburg University (13,

#### Preparing the modules reports

The grant coordinator insisted on all relevant partners to prepare the modules reports according to the suggested template for all ToT.

#### Training replication

14,15 of July 2021)

Concerning Training replication, partners discussed this issue in details and several options were proposed: one of the option was to make one training replication after all ToT in each partner country, and the other option was to hold one training in each country after each ToT and all participants from partner institutions contribute to the trainings. The replication may be face to face or virtual depending on the situation in each country.

Dr. Bassem Kaissi proposed the following scenario:

\*To be in line with the comments and recommendations of the EACEA in the project implementation report (specifically: avoiding delays), he suggested a "national" event for the training replication of ToTI in June and for ToTI in July (one in Lebanon and another one in Syria for each ToT-Each for one training day). This will help in creating/delivering synergy and will take into consideration the targets/KPIs included in the project application and the varying sizes (in terms of faculty/student numbers) of the partner universities.

\*August is normally a vacation in Europe, Lebanon, and Syria.

\*ToT III training replication in September and ToT IV training replication in October. Face-to face events might be considered/arranged based on the COVID-19 status in the relevant country(ies).

It was agreed to adopt the last scenario.

#### Morale e-Learning platform

The grant coordinator noted that all materials need to be available on one server after the end of the project, currently, they are hosted on a BAU server.
